

Federation Council is soon to commence water main cleaning in the township of Corowa in August.

The air scouring process will take approximately 10 to 14 days to complete and customers will receive a letter informing them of dates and times their water supply will be affected.

During the cleaning process customers may encounter dirty or discoloured water over the 7 to 10 days.

Due to the ongoing commitment by Council to maintain a quality water supply for our townships, water mains are cleaned on an annual basis.

COUNCIL INTRODUCES ONLINE RATES PAYMENTS
