Two sessions will be held as part of the initiative, which aims to facilitate a range of services and information that will assist residents currently being affected by the drought that is crippling much of the state.

The Australian Government Mobile Bus Centre will be visiting Urana and Oaklands and have confirmed that a Rural Financial Counsellor and Farm Household Officer will be on hand to speak with residents.

The drought support available is in addition to the convenient access to Australian Government payments and services that the mobile bus centre provides rural communities.

To coincide with the visit from the mobile bus centre, Council has coordinated a number of other service providers, with a particular focus on supporting the health and well being of local farming communities.

Residents are being encouraged to join council staff and Councillors for a free BBQ in Urana at the Memorial Hall from 9:30am – 12 noon and in Oaklands at the CWA Hall between 1:30pm - 4pm.
