FUN PARK PROPOSAL

Federation Council has received a request to lease land within the Ball Park Precinct in Corowa known as the old Tractor Pull area adjacent to the Lawn Tennis Club (Part of 2 Riesling Street Corowa).

The intention of the group is to establish a Fun Park at this location which would include water slides. The land is currently maintained by Council as public open space and is a dog off-leash area.

As this is land classified community land, the Local Government Act stipulates a number of requirements that would need to be met to allow this land to be considered for a lease by a business.

Council is seeking to establish the views of the community in relation to leasing this section of land to a private business for the purposes outlined. Any interested person may inspect this proposal and draft plans at the Corowa Civic Centre, 100 Edward Street, Corowa from Wednesday, 1 March 2017 to Wednesday, 22 March 2017 between the hours of 8.30 am and 5:00pm Monday to Friday.

Submissions received will form part of a report to Council which is intended to be a public document. Should you not wish any personal details or your submission to be publicly released, please advise this in your submission. Please note that a development application has not been submitted so Council has not vet made any planning assessment of the proposal, this will be a required process.

Submissions in relation to this current consultation are not allowed to form part of any planning submissions received when the development application is formally exhibited once lodged, so writers are advised they will need to resubmit if they wish to make submissions on the planning assessment of this proposal.

MEN'S SHED PROPOSAL

Federation Council, has been approached by the Corowa Tree of Life Community Garden requesting that consideration be given to granting use of Unit Y (44 Queen Street, Corowa) for the purpose of housing a future Men's Shed in accordance with the NSW Men's Shed Association and Constitution.

Council has provided in principle support towards leasing this facility to the group subject to the proposal being placed on public display to enable members of the community to consider this proposal.

Council are exploring possible partnership opportunities with the group that may allow the continued delivery of some youth activities or programs from the building and opportunities for the wider community to participate in activities.
