### TEMPORARY CHANGED TRAFFIC CONDITIONS GREAT VICTORIAN BIKE RIDE

A 60km speed reduction along Spring Drive between Corowa and Mulwala will occur on event day.

- Parliament Street, Corowa
- Gray Street, Corowa
- Federation Avenue, Corowa, Spring Drive, Corowa Road, Mulwala
   Malbauraa Streat Mulwala
- Melbourne Street, MulwalaGulai Road, Mulwala
- Mulwala to Yarrawonga via Weir Road, Mulwala

Residents will still have access to their properties, however, it's recommended that residents allow extra time or seek alternative routes if possible. However, if travel must occur in areas where there are a large number of cyclists on the road, Bicycle Network asks that you remember to:

- Obey all road rules.
- Allow for plenty of clearance when overtaking cyclists.
- Be aware of oncoming traffic when overtaking cyclists.
  Allow ample travel time as an average cyclist will ride between 20-35 km/h.
