### TEMPORARY STREET CLOSURE SATURDAY 31 MARCH 2018

Council advises that the following temporary Corowa Street closures will occur from 6:00AM to 4:00PM on Saturday 31 March 2018 for the purpose of the safe conduct of the Australian Billy Cart Championships.

- SANGER STREET, between Isabel Street and the roundabout at the bottom.
- CHURCH STREET, and Sanger Street
- MARY STREET, FULL LENGTH
- RIVER STREET, between Sanger Street and rear of Royal Hotel

Detours will be via adjacent streets via Edward Street, Riesling Street and Isabel Street or via Queen Street and Parliament Street and will be adequately signposted.

Bus passengers please note that the River Street bus stop has been temporarily relocated to Riesling Street whilst the road closure is in place.
