COROWA SWIMMING POOL DEVELOPMENT - HAVE YOUR SAY!

At the Ordinary Council Meeting on Tuesday 17 April, Federation Council resolved to support, on an in principle basis the Corowa Swimming Pool development option 4. This option will see Council develop a seasonal outdoor 50 metre X 8 lane Pool and 10 X 16 metre learn to swim pool as well as a separate water play area.

Following a public meeting on Monday 26 March, Council placed the Draft Corowa Swim Centre Options Report on public display. This report investigated the development of five alternative Swimming Pool development options and three options were shortlisted by Council including both indoor and outdoor pool configurations.

Option 4 proposed a new shared entry and administration centre from the Ball Park Caravan Park but this component of the project may be considered by Council at a later stage.

Residents are encouraged to have their say on the development option, with the closing date for submissions being Tuesday 1 May 2018.

This date enables the consideration of feedback prior to a final decision being made at the 15 May 2018 Council meeting.
