CHILEAN NEEDLE GRASS

Chilean Needle Grass is a Weed of National Significance and occurs within many areas of the Murray region including Federation Council where it is a priority weed for containment. This highly invasive grass species can:

- Take over pastures.
- Halve productivity during Summer.
- Injure animal eyes.
- Downgrade wool.
- Pierce hides.
- Affect meat quality.
- Reduce biodiversity.

Seeds are spread via animals, vehicles and machinery and also in hay movement if contaminated. Now is the time to be on the lookout as it actively grows and develops its seed set. If you suspect you have found Chilean Needle Grass please contact Council who can provide advice on management and control methods.
