Council is seeking tenders from suitably qualified and experienced contractors for the construction of a Multipurpose Hall and Gymnasium in Howlong. The work also involves an upgrade of the Howlong Football & Netball facilities within the same facility.

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES

Council advises that the following temporary Corowa road closures will occur from 7:00am to 6:00pm from Wednesday 4 September to Thursday 12 September for the purpose of undertaking drainage works.

The intersection of Edward and Riesling Streets Corowa including approximately 100 metres north of Riesling Street. Residential access will remain via Sanger and River Streets. Continued access for Emergency Vehicles will be made available.

The road will be fully opened outside the above work hours.

Detours will be via adjacent streets including Sanger and River Streets and will be adequately signposted.
