Council is seeking tenders from suitably qualified and experienced contractors for the construction of the Ball Park Multisport Pavilion in Corowa.

This is a new building to replace ageing facilities that were incorporated as part of the administration and amenities building for the former Corowa Pool on the same site.

The existing facilities are being demolished as part of the Corowa Aquatic Centre project and as such a full replacement is required. Demolition is not part of this Tender and will be carried out by others.

Plans have been developed in conjunction with the core user groups, being the Corowa Cricket and Hockey Clubs.

Tenderers are required to lodge tenders through Council's e-Tendering Portal (Tenderlink). The use of this system requires Tenderers to be registered with the portal. The portal can be found at <https://million.tenderlink.com>.

No charge is made for documents downloaded through this site.

## WATER MAINS CLEANING

In order to ensure the highest quality of water for our community, Federation Council routinely performs watermain cleaning programs. The program is in place to minimize the occurrence of discoloured water and ensure residents receive the freshest water possible by removing accumulated material from the watermains.

Federation Council wishes to advise that it will commence water mains cleaning in Howlong and Mulwala from Monday 30 September.

The air scouring process will take approximately 10 to 14 days to complete and customers will receive a letter informing them of dates and times their water supply will be affected.

During the cleaning process residents may encounter dirty or discoloured water over 7 to 10 days.
