

FEDERATION COUNCIL ELECTION

Saturday, 9th September 2017

Election of 9 Councillors

You need to be enrolled to vote for the council where you live

To check your enrolment details visit our website or call us. If you are not on the roll in NSW or your current enrolment details are not correct you may be eligible to enrol or up-date your details when you vote early or on election day.

To newly enrol, or up-date your details on the spot, just bring your NSW photo driver licence or NSW Photo Card showing your current address, and be ready to provide Australian citizenship details if you were born overseas.

Voting on election day

Voting will take place on Saturday, 9th September 2017 between the hours of 8am and 6pm.

On election day you must vote at a polling place for your council, or your ward if your council is divided. There is no absent voting at local government (council) elections. To check your enrolment details visit our website or call us.

You can apply online for a postal vote from www.votensw.info or by calling 1300 135 736. Your application must be completed and received by the NSW Electoral Commission no later than 5pm Monday, 4th September 2017.

STRONGER COUNTRY COMMUNITIES

Federation Council has the opportunity to apply for funding under the Stronger Country Communities program being administered by the NSW Government.

The funding program is part of the \$1.3 billion Regional Growth Fund designed to ensure regional areas have quality infrastructure that improves the liveability of communities across NSW.

Council will prepare applications for the following projects;

- Toilet Block Improvements
- Howlong Preschool Expansion
- Urana Caravan Park Improvements
- Extension of Corowa Cycleway

Each of these projects have previously been identified as important priorities for the community through various consultation processes and council planning documents.

Council must prioritise these projects and submit its applications by 13 September. Following this, the NSW Government will consult further with the community as part of the assessment process. A sample of 100 residents will be randomly selected to participate in a phone survey to determine what projects are the most important to the community.

To assist with prioritising the applications, residents are being encouraged to visit Council's website to learn more about each project and complete a short survey by 12 noon Monday 4 September.
