PUBLIC EXHIBITION - ALLOCATION OF FUNDS TO WEST CORUGAN PRIVATE IRRIGATION DISTRICT

This money will be used to part fund the installation of a syphon system under the channel network near Daysdale.

Food Waste Processing Facility 21-25 Poseidon Road Corowa Designated Development
