DRAFT LONG TERM FINANCIAL PLAN 2023 -2032 PROPOSED ADDENDUM

At its December meeting, Council resolved to place the Draft Long Term Financial Plan 2023 – 2032 Proposed Addendum on public exhibition for a period of 28 days. Council is inviting residents to review the proposed addendum and provide any feedback by 5pm, Wednesday 18 January 2023. Council's Long Term Financial Plan 2022 2032 was adopted in June 2022. Following this further progress has been made on asset management information with the preparation of the draft Strategic Asset Management Plan 2022 - 2032 and the State of Our Council Infrastructure Assets 2022 which details the current condition of Council's infrastructure. In addition, Council's Financial Statements for the year ended 30 June 2022 have been finalised with key financial indicators presented by Council's external auditor representative, Crowe Albury, at the November 2022 Council meeting. The addendum provides additional asset management financial information following the preparation of the draft Strategic Asset Management Plan for 2022-2032 and the financial performance and position of Council if the proposed Special Rate Variation is not approved.
