### RESPONSIBILITIES OF PET OWNERS

Being a pet owner means there are responsibilities by law that are required to be adhered to.

To ensure the safety of your pet and the community, residents are reminded of some of the responsibilities of pet ownership to ensure your pet lives a full and happy life:

- Registration.
- Microchipping.
- Wearing a collar and identification tag with the name of the dog or cat, address or telephone number of the owner when in a public place.
- If you have moved residences, updating your contact details on your pet registration and microchipping records.
- When you take your dog to a public place they must be under the owners' effective control. This means on an adequate, leash, chain or cord. If your dog is in an off leash area, it must be under your effective control.
- Provide a secure home environment so your dog cannot escape.

Our furry friends are so important in our lives and at Council, there is no better joy for our rangers to be able to return your pet home safely, however, if the above items are not followed we may not know where to return it to.

### WASTE MANAGEMENT SERVICES

Federation Council has resolved to alter the Corowa, Howlong and Mulwala tip opening hours at the October monthly meeting of Council.

In July 2021, a number of changes were introduced in respect to tip opening times and days of the three waste facilities in Corowa, Howlong and Mulwala which resulted in Council receiving high numbers of written community submissions in that the preferred opening day of Council's waste facilities over the weekend period was a Sunday, rather than a Saturday.

The new opening hours from Tuesday 9 November, 2021 will be:

- Corowa: Tuesday 9am - 12 noon & Sunday 1pm - 4pm.
- Howlong: Tuesday 1pm - 4pm & Sunday 9am - 12 noon.
- Mulwala: Wednesday 9am - 12 noon & Sunday 9am - 1pm.
