HAVE YOUR SAY ON PLANS FOR NEW MULWALA BRIDGE

Federation Council is encouraging local residents to provide feedback to help determine the preferred alignment for a new bridge crossing at Lake Mulwala on the State's Victorian border. The NSW and Victorian State Governments are calling for community feedback to help progress planning for a new bridge, which will not only create a more accessible crossing of Lake Mulwala for freight operators, but will also eliminate ongoing maintenance costs of the old bridge.

Submissions can be made through an online portal, or by email, post or phone until 30 July. An online community information session will be held on **Wednesday, 14 July at 1pm** via nswroads.work/mulwalabridgeqanda. A mapping tool displaying both route options is now available on the project website at nswroads.work/mulwalabridge. The community will be able to submit feedback within the mapping tool to specific areas along both routes. Federation Council will be submitting a joint paper with past consultation findings, and to highlight the many green route advantages with Moira Shire Council.
