LOWERING OF LAKE MULWALA

Federation Council would like to remind residents and visitors that the gradual lowering of water in Lake Mulwala begins this week.

You'll notice the lake level will drop 5 metres gradually over the next 4 to 6 weeks so the Murray-Darling Basin Authority and Goulburn-Murray Water can control an invasive waterweed Egeria Densa and undertake other maintenance. It's a great time for lake residents and water users who draw water directly from the lake to inspect and fix their own infrastructure, such as jetties, boat ramps, retaining walls and pipe intakes.
