SELECTIVE HERBICIDE APPLICATIONS

This annual program removes broadleaf weeds, reducing mowing frequencies and improving turf density.

The selective herbicide that will be used is Javelin (20g/l

Clopyralid, 15g/l Diflufenican, 300g/l Mcpa).

Federation Council advises that there are significant delays to all applications being lodged for each stage of the development process. Staff shortages, in conjunction with the increasing complexity of the NSW Planning Portal Processes required to be undertaken by Council has seen pre-lodgement assessment times increasing to 6-8 weeks and average determination times taking between 10-12 weeks. We ask you for your cooperation as Council officers concentrate on clearing the backlog of applications while maintaining all other legislated services.

ON EXHIBITION - NEW FEES & CHARGES - UNDERGROUND PETROLEUM STORAGE **SYSTEMS**

Council reviewed and endorsed the new fees and charges for Underground Petroleum Storage Systems at its July ordinary Meeting for public exhibition for a period of 28 days.

Underground petroleum storage systems (UPSS) sites are highly regulated in NSW given their risk of leaks and contamination. From Friday 1 September 2019 State Government delegated responsibility of regulating most sites to local governments.

EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

Federation Council has recently initiated a project to prepare detailed designs for an upgrade of the existing flood protection levee bank at Urana township. The detailed design of the levee is being undertaken by consultants Dryside Engineering for Council. As part of the levee design project, Council is inviting Expressions of Interest from local landholders for potential borrow pit sites which contain material with a high clay content Borrow pits found to contain suitable material could be used to source material for the levee construction. An estimated 25,000 to 30,000 cubic metres of material will be required. This project includes investigation, concept and detailed design of an extension and upgrade of the existing levee.
