Federation Council at its July 2024 meeting resolved to publicly exhibit the draft Corowa, Howlong & Mulwala Flood Study for a period of 28 days. The draft Flood Study report will be on public exhibition from Wednesday 14 August through to Wednesday 11 September, 2024 inclusive.

The Flood Study presents the results of detailed investigations into both Murray River and local runoff flooding conditions, focusing on impacts to the townships of Corowa, Howlong and
