BUILDING WORKS SANGER STREET COROWA

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE PROPOSAL

In accordance with Section 356 of the Local Government Act 1993, Council proposes to provide a reduced rent arrangement for a furnished residence for a Medical Doctor to relocate to Urana and service the Oaklands Medical Centre.
