KERBSIDE BIN COLLECTION CALENDARS

Do you forget which bins to put out each week for kerbside waste collection?

No more guessing, download the 2024 kerbside bin collection calendar from our website or collect one from Council offices in Corowa, Howlong and Mulwala.

Some Helpful Tips:

- Be mindful not to overload the bins maximum weight is 80kg.
- Place the bin close to the kerb with the handle facing toward your property. • Place your bin out the night before your collection day or by

6am on the morning of collection. Keep clear of overhanging branches and power lines.

Please leave at least one metre between bins and other objects, including fences and vehicles.

CHANGED TRAFFIC CONDITIONS ON MULWALA BRIDGE

Motorists are advised of changed traffic conditions on Mulwala Bridge over the Murray River for maintenance work to be carried out.

Transport for NSW is undertaking work under the bridge from a barge and will involve installing steel plates underneath the bridge supports. Work will be carried out between 7am and 5pm weekdays to mid-April, causing minimal impacts to traffic.

As work progresses, a reduced speed limit of 40 km/h will be in place across the bridge, 24 hours a day, and is expected to come into effect

Motorists are advised to allow an additional five minutes of travel time, drive to the conditions and follow the directions of signs and traffic

The car park on the NSW side of the bridge will be closed during this period while the area is used as a site compound.
