Federation Council advises that there are significant delays to all applications being lodged for each stage of the development process. Staff shortages, in conjunction with the increasing complexity of the NSW Planning Portal Processes required to be undertaken by Council has seen pre-lodgement assessment times increasing to 6-8 weeks and average determination times taking between 10-12 weeks. We ask you for your cooperation as Council officers concentrate on clearing the backlog of applications while maintaining all other legislated services.

## MULWALA PIONEER MUSEUM CLOSED DUE TO STRUCTURAL ISSUES

Federation Council has announced the regrettable immediate closure of the Mulwala Pioneer Museum due to serious structural issues identified in recent engineering reports that severely places at risk the structural adequacy of the building. The decision whilst difficult was necessary to prioritise the safety of visitors and volunteers. Federation Council acknowledges the impact this closure will have on the Yarrawonga & Mulwala Historical Society and its dedicated volunteers. The Council is committed to working closely with the Society to explore all possible options for the future. While immediate public access is not possible, the Council is exploring the possibility of limited, conditional access for volunteer staff to retrieve and secure items. ## ROAD AND FOOTPATH INSPECTIONS UNDERWAY SOON

Federation Council is committed to maintaining and improving our extensive road and footpath network. To help us do this, we've engaged the Infrastructure Management Group (IMG) to conduct a comprehensive assessment of our:

- 979km of sealed roads 1460km of unsealed roads
- 105km of footpaths

Starting **Thursday 13 March**, you'll likely see IMG's inspection vehicles and quad bikes around the Federation Council area. These vehicles will be equipped with cameras and laser measurement devices to assess the condition of our roads and footpaths.

- Road Survey: Look out for transporter-style vehicles travelling at normal traffic speeds.
- Footpath Survey: Quad bikes will be inspecting footpaths at a brisk walking pace.

Rest assured that all vehicles will be operated by experienced personnel with hazard lights and warning devices in use. Inspection work will begin **Thursday 13 March** and take approximately one - two weeks to complete. This assessment is crucial for helping us understand the current condition of our transport network. The data collected will inform future renewal and maintenance programs, ensuring safer and more efficient travel for everyone in our community. We thank you for your cooperation during this period.
