Following the recent announcement by Australia Post that mail deliveries to households will be reduced from a daily service, Council has extended the timeframe for responses to Development Application Notifications from 14 days to 21 days. Federation Council advises that there are significant delays to all applications being lodged for each stage of the development process. Staff shortages, in conjunction with the increasing complexity of the NSW Planning Portal Processes required to be undertaken by Council has seen pre-lodgement assessment times increasing to 6-8 weeks and average determination times taking between 10-12 weeks. We ask you for your cooperation as Council officers concentrate on clearing the backlog of applications while maintaining all other legislated services.

URANA LEVEE UPGRADE & MORUNDAH FLOOD MITIGATION DESIGN PROJECTS - HAVE YOUR SAY!

NEW 3 BIN SYSTEM - URANA AND SURROUNDING VILLAGES AND SOME OF OUR SOUTHERN VILLAGES

Federation Council will introduce a new system of waste collection from July 2024 to divert organics away from landfill for Urana and surrounding villages and some of our southern villages. The new "3 bin" system will allow food and garden waste to be collected from households. Households will receive three separate 240-litre bins, with organics collected weekly, and recycling and general waste collected fortnightly.

A new red lid bin for rubbish, a yellow lid bin for recycling and green lid bin for organics will be provided. In June, the following areas will be delivered new bins, a kitchen caddy, a collection calendar, compostable liners and an information pack to explain these changes.

With the new 3 bin system you'll have more space which means less waste that will end up in landfill which is better for our environment and our future.
